The Lowe Syndrome Trust was founded in June 2000 by parents of a child diagnosed with the disease at the age of 6.

The aim of the trust is to raise funding for research into Lowe syndrome – a devastating incurable genetic disease that affects thousands of little boys worldwide with cataracts (born either blind or partially sighted), stunted growth, poor muscle tone (some never walk), rickets, arthritis, kidney problems, seizures and mental impairment – just to name a few of the symptoms. In spite of these handicaps, the little boys have extremely happy and cheeky personalities. Sadly few survive to become adults

The Lowe Syndrome Trust is small and voluntary, but already we have 7 research projects underway (Great Ormond Street, Imperial College London, University College London, Institute of Ophthalmology, Dundee University, Addenbrooke’s Cambridge and most recently to Professor Robert Nussbaum, University of California, San Francisco). All these projects are funded by events such as the Masquerade Ball. Research is vitally needed to help these children live longer, healthier, happier lives.

The Trust is the only charity in the UK for the disease and the only charity worldwide totally dedicated to raising funding to support research.

There is no UK Government support or research of this disease.
